



## LONDON ROAD CEMETERY, THATCHAM

### FEE SCHEDULE FROM 01 APRIL 2019

**FEES, PAYMENTS AND SUMS** fixed and settled by the Thatcham Town Council by virtue of the powers invested in them under the Local Government Act, 1972 and order(s) made thereunder.

The fees, payments and sums set out in Parts I, II, III and IV shall apply in the following circumstances. In all other circumstances the fees shall be trebled.

1. Where the person to be interred was a resident within the Parish of Thatcham immediately before the date of death.
2. Where an Exclusive Right of Burial is purchased for the purpose of interring a person who was a resident of the parish immediately before the date of death.
3. Any subsequent interment by virtue of the benefit of that Right where the deceased was a resident of the Parish of Thatcham immediately before the date of death.
4. Where an Exclusive Right of Burial is purchased by a person who is a resident in the Parish of Thatcham at the time of purchase.

*(However, all fees in Parts I, III and IV will be trebled if the deceased was not a resident of the Parish of Thatcham at the time of death and had lived outside the Parish for longer than two years.)*

5. Where the death of a person, normally resident and with a permanent address within the Parish, occurs outside the Parish at a hospital or similar establishment where the deceased has been admitted for treatment.
6. Where an Exclusive Right of Burial is purchased for the purpose of interring a person whose death occurs outside the Parish at a hospital or similar establishment where the deceased has been admitted for treatment and who is normally resident and with a permanent address within the Parish.

#### **Part I – INTERMENTS**

The fees indicated for the various headings in Part I:

- (a) Do not include the digging of a grave into which a coffin is interred;
- (b) Apply only where the interment is commenced between the hours of 10am and 3.30 pm on Monday to Thursday inclusive or 10am to 2.30 pm on Friday;
- (c) In any other case an additional £39 is payable;
- (d) **Where a grave is dug for cremated remains by Council Staff, the charge is £35.00.**

## **PART I - FOR ANY INTERMENT**

1.	Of the body of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years in an earthen grave 4'6" x 4' (137cm x 121cm)	£109.00
2.	Of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years.	£316.00
3.	Of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years and in a casket.	£367.00
4.	Of cremated remains.	£204.00
5.	Of cremated remains of two persons in a single casket. This will be charged at 1.5 times the single cremated remains fee.	£306.00
6.	Scattering of cremated remains under a lifted turf. This is not available in the new cremated remains Section J within the New Lawn Section.	£204.00

## **PART II - EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN AN EARTHEN GRAVE**

The fees indicated for the various headings of this part in Deed of Grant and all the expenses thereof.

For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave:

1.	2' x 2' (61cm x 61cm)	Cremated remains	£238.00
2.	4'6" x 4'0" (137cm x 122cm)	Body of a child under 12 years of age	£316.00
3.	9'0" x 4'6" (274cm x 137cm)	Body of a person over 12 years of age	£552.00
4.	10' x 5' (305cm x 152cm)	Casket	£664.00

## **Part III - MEMORIAL STONES AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS**

For the right to erect on a grave in respect of which the Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted.

1.	A headstone, cross or monument, with or without kerbstones, including the first inscription in the Memorial Lawn Section.	£118.00
2.	A headstone, with or without incorporated vase, including the first inscription in the Modern Lawn Section.	£118.00
3.	For each inscription after the first.	£50.00
4.	Vase.	£50.00
