Emailed WBC Response from Parking Manager as follows:

"The Council is proposing to implement a Parking Order to control the parking within the car park that serves the Kennet Leisure Centre. For some years the patrons of the Kennet Leisure Centre have voiced their frustrations at being unable to find a parking space. The Parking Order will serve to remove those vehicles that are left for long periods by persons who do not use the leisure centre and it will thereby optimise the parking opportunities for the patrons. There are seventy eight parking spaces in the car park and the Parking Order proposes twenty-eight parking spaces to be allocated to the Kennet School for their exclusive use in term time on weekdays between 7.30 am and 5.30 pm. In addition to the permits being issued to the school another twenty permits will be issued to the Kennet Leisure for distribution to their staff. This will leave a minimum of thirty spaces for use by patrons of the Kennet Leisure Centre on weekdays between 7.30 am and 5.30 pm, with another twenty-eight available outside these hours and during school holiday periods. After implementation the Council will monitor parking activity in the roads immediately adjacent to the school to determine if displaced vehicles are parking there and adversely affecting the residents."
